**ORDER**

*The Director of Technical Education has forwarded the proposal for the deputation of 13 members of faculty in various Government Engineering Colleges and 3 members of faculties in Aided Engineering Colleges in the state under QIP scheme at various QIP Centres for undergoing M.Tech., M.Arch. and Ph.D programmes for the year 2015-2016 and for the pre-registration to Ph.D programme under 60 days contact programme in respect of 16 members of faculty in Government Engineering Colleges and 9 members of faculty in Aided Engineering Colleges for the year 2015-16. The Screening Committee meeting held on 18.6.2015 have examined the proposal and found that:*

*In the Government Order read as 5<sup>th</sup> paper above, it was ordered that the QIP deputation will not be allowed to minor QIP Centres from the academic year 2014-15.*

*As per the QIP Prospectus, all the QIP Centres in the country except IITs and IISc, Bangalore, are classified as Minor Centres. Even the NITs are classified as Minor Centres. During the screening of applications for Ph.D/M.Tech. by the Screening Committee, it was revealed that 12*

candidates were allotted for Ph.D and 3 candidates for M.Tech and one candidate for M.Arch by the Principal Co-ordinator, QIP Programme to Minor Centres.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to amend the Government Order read as 5<sup>th</sup> paper above to the effect that 'Aspirants to Ph.D and M.Tech allotted to Minor Centres, within and outside the State will be allowed to register for the programmes, subject to the condition that the faculty member working in a particular Minor Centre will not be allowed to register for the Ph.D/M.Tech/M.Arch in the same Centre. The relaxation issued in respect of Minor QIP Centre is applicable only to the applicants for M.Tech./M.Arch./Ph.D for the year 2015 only. This condition is to ensure the following objectives, which will facilitate enhancing of the quality of technical education in the state.

- (a) Better focus of the candidate on academics
- (b) Effective evaluation of the academic performance of the candidate and
- (c) To expose the candidate to a different academic environment.

The Screening Committee held on 18.6.2015 approved the list of 13 faculties of various Government Engineering Colleges, 3 faculties of Aided Engineering Colleges for M.Tech/am.Arch/Ph.D Programme during 2015-16. The Committee also selected 14 faculties of Government Engineering Colleges and 9 faculties of Aided Engineering Colleges for 60 days Pre-Registration Programme during 2015-16.

Accordingly Government are also pleased to approve the decision of the Screening Committee and order for the deputation of the members of faculty under QIP scheme subject to the following

- (1) The orders contained in the circular read as 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above except those relating to ensuring of 80% staff strength shall be complied with.
- (2) The Director of Technical Education shall ensure that the academic requirements of the students are in no way affected and that no complaint in this regard from students are raised (Director of Technical Education, Principals and teachers will be viewed seriously and appropriate action will be taken by Government).
- (3) Only those appointed in substantive vacancies on a regular basis

*shall be deputed (teachers appointed against leave vacancies , temporary vacancies, deputation vacancies, short term vacancies shall not be deputed).*

*(4) The resultant vacancies shall be filled up as per the Government Order read as 4<sup>th</sup> paper above.*

*(5) The Director of Technical Education shall give permission to relieve the teachers only after executing the bond as required in Government Order read as first and third paper above.*

*(6) The Director of Technical Education is authorised to issue necessary orders in this regard with regard to the above points.*
